Finally, you will be able to explore the Okavango delta by safari vehicle, Morkoro or even on foot.

~ Itinerary Description ~

Day 1: Arrive Moremi Game Reserve

Arrive today in Moremi Game Reserve and transfer to Okuti Lodge for your overnight accommodation. Daily game activities are included and you will have evenings free to explore or opt to relax in the lodge.

This delightful camp lies alongside the Maunachira River which flows through the Xakanaxa Lagoon within the world-renowned Moremi Game Reserve. Okuti is built amidst the wilderness of one of Botswana's prime game-viewing regions, affording a highly diverse game-viewing experience.

Day 2: Full Day in the Reserve

Today, you will have the opportunity to spend the whole day exploring the area and getting acquainted with the African Bush.

The Moremi Game Reserve is regarded as one of the most incredible wildlife reserves in the world. It is a photographer's delight, while the area's remote location has ensured that the fragile wildlife has not been subject to the destructive practices of mass tourism.

Experience game drives in specially-designed safari vehicles, allowing unhindered views for game watching and photography. Moremi is a park rich in wildlife and game viewing is consistent year round, an ideal destination for the first-time visitor to Botswana.

Day 3 – 5: Shinde Private Concession

Wake up early this morning and transfer to Young Explorers in the Shinde Private Concession.

Based at Footsteps Camp, Young Explorers is a specially-designed safari offering families the opportunity to discover the wonders of the African wilderness together. Under the surface, however, you will discover that the Young Explorers program is much more than a safari experience. Families have exclusive use of the private, six-bedded camp, two professional guides, personal chef, waiter, housekeeper, and mokoro guides. You are there to explore the bush at your leisure, while never losing sight of the fact that being in the wilderness is also about having fun. Kids learn bush survival skills and about tracking animals on their own custom-tailored safaris.

Day 6 & 7: Okavango Delta

Depart early this morning for the southwestern side of the Okavango Delta. Accommodation for the next two nights will be at Kanana Camp.

Kanana Camp is located in the remote inner reaches of the Delta. Eight luxury-style tents, accommodating up to 16 guests, with the common facilities of the camp are built on stilts to ensure a good view of the floodplains for all visitors. The area is an excellent walking and walking venue. While game viewing in 4x4 vehicles is very popular, one can best experience this region by viewing game on foot or by gliding silently through the delta by Mokoro.

Day 8: Departure

This morning you will bid farewell to your journey and transfer to the airstrip for your flight back to Maun.

The tour price includes the following services.

- Scheduled light aircraft transfers to and from Maun and between camps & departure taxes where applicable.

- Accommodation at the hotels, game lodges or rest camps specified in the itinerary, on the basis of two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with en suite bathroom, or shower / toilets.
- Meals from arrival in camp on day 1 to the end of the scheduled safari and a reasonable amount of drinks excluding premium, imported brands.
- Transportation by 4X4 specially designed safari vehicle, with qualified driver, for all journeys specified.
- Laundry, Activities specified, private vehicle, and park fees for sightseeing excursions specified.
- English Speaking tour guide
- Full Pre-departure and final documentation with detailed “Guide to Planning your African Safari”.

Services Not Included:

- International airfare, flights to/from Kasane or between non-Ker & Downey properties, airport taxes and visa fees, quoted separately
- Young Explorers at Footsteps Camp is excluded in December only as it is not available.
- Items of a personal nature, such as telephone calls, room service, premium imported brand beverages, personal purchases, optional extra activities, etc.
- Gratuities to tour guides, drivers and restaurant staff for services rendered.
- Any other services not specified above.

Deposit and Booking Requirements

- This quotation is subject to the availability of all services at the time of making a reservation.
- Travel insurance coverage for injury, illness or loss of effects while on tour is NOT included, is highly recommended for travel and compulsory for many lodges and adventure safaris in Southern and Eastern Africa.
- **Registration:** A 25% deposit of the total land price, per person is required. The remainder of the cost is due 60 days prior to departure date. Airline tickets must be purchased within two weeks of reservation confirmation.
- **Payment** is accepted by personal check, company check or credit card.
- **Reservation Policy:** All tariffs quoted include VAT and current grading levy. The price quoted is subject to change in the event of any unforeseen increases in fuel costs including currency fluctuations and/or Government levies/taxes, including Park Fees and Entrance fees. Safariline reserves the right to amend the quoted tariffs accordingly should the Government change the percentage level of VAT or introduce any other tax or Levy. Safariline will not cancel a tour, holiday or other travel arrangement once the client has paid in full unless it becomes necessary to do so as a result of hostilities, war or threat of war, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist unrest, active or threatened natural or nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions or if a group tour does not have a minimum required participants, or for any other adverse event beyond the control of Safariline. - **Cancellations:** Cancellations received more than 60 days prior to departure will be subject to the nonrefundable \$500.00 per person fee plus any charge incurred by the hotels, ground handlers or operators up to the entire deposit of ,25% of the total trip costs
