~Itinerary~

Day 1 Johannesburg / Makuleke Conservancy

Depart Johannesburg Lanseria Airport this morning by lite aircraft for the Northern Kruger National Park. Overnight and safari at Pafuri Camp before beginning your hiking adventure. Meals: L/D + Lodge Activities

Days 2- 4 Pafuri Walking Trails

Led by an experienced armed guide and tracker, explore this magnificent region of the northern Kruger on foot, connect with the surrounding wilderness. Immerse yourself in the sounds of the African night in walk-in dome tents, from lions roaring to porcupines rustling in the undergrowth. There is an astounding diversity here at Pafuri! Walk daily from camp site to camp site and feel the freedom of adventure.

Day 5 Mpumalanga & Elephant Whispers

Depart by lite aircraft for the Kruger Mpumalanga Airport and transfer to Hippo Hollow for overnight. Later this afternoon, enjoy your Sunset Elephant interaction safari before returning to the lodge for overnight. Dinner on own at the lodge or nearby. Meal = B

Days 6 – 9 Rocktail Beach, Maputaland

This morning transfer to the airport for flight via Johannesburg to Richards Bay and the tropical shade of the Maputaland Coastal Forest. The World Heritage Site & Marine Reserve lies just offshore from Rocktail Beach Camp. This reserve provides sanctuary for marine life with extraordinary diving and snorkeling encounters and huge shoals of fish, dolphins and whale. For the next four days enjoy World-class diving, snorkeling and other adventures on these remote, unspoiled beaches. The lodge has 12 tented rooms set back in shaded sanctuary of the lush coastal forest. Meals: B/L/D + Lodge Activities (SCUBA additional)

Day 10 Departure or Cape Town Extension

Depart this morning for Richards Bay and your flight to Johannesburg. Meet your international flight or continue on to Cape Town for the Shark Safari Extension.
