Day 1: Arrive in Tanzania / Serengeti

Arrive in Tanzania and make your way to Grumeti Private reserve and your luxury accommodations. Once there, you will have the opportunity to settle in before beginning your adventure.

Day 2-6: Serengeti National Park

Grumeti, situated adjacent to the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania, is an integral part of the Serengeti-Mara Ecosystem, the home of the Great Migration. The reserve was created by the Tanzanian government in 1994 in order to protect the path of the annual wildebeest migration and the indigenous biodiversity of this vast and important ecosystem.

You will spend the next five days here, exploring both Grumeti and the adjacent Serengeti National Park with your highly trained guides and relaxing at the lodge with spa treatments and gourmet cuisine. Each day will offer you a new and exciting experience and each night you will fall asleep under the star-studded African sky to the sounds of the bush.

Day 7: Overnight in Nairobi

Today, you will transfer to Nairobi for an overnight stay while en-route to Seychelles. Get a taste of the bustling city as you look forward to the sun-soaked beaches of next leg of your journey. You will have the opportunity to spend

the night on your own, relaxing in your Nairobi hotel room or exploring a little bit of the night life. Enjoy a sumptuous meal at one of the local restaurants and a good night's sleep before departing the following day.

Day 8-11: Fregate Island Private

This morning, transfer to Mahé and board your helicopter flight to Fregate Island Private. On arrival, you will have time to settle in to your accommodations and begin to get a feel for your new exquisite surroundings.

Beautifully located for a wide range of activities, Fregate House is where you find the reception desk and boutique, library, main restaurant, a collection of old rums and whiskies, a wine-tasting cellar in the basement and, just outside, the charming Pirates Bar beach hut. Walking down to the main beach from Fregate House, you pass by the two common pools and the beach bar. As one of the first ports of call on Fregate Island, it is the perfect starting point for a relaxing and inspiring stay.

Spend the next four days soaking up the sun, exploring the island, relaxing, and enjoying the wide variety of games and activities on offer. With seven beaches, 11km of rainforest, and your own private assistant, privacy and intrigue are ensured.

Day 12: Departure

Bid farewell to this beach haven as you board your helicopter flight back to Mahé and picking up your connection flights home.

***Activities at Fregate:** Deep sea fishing, intro scuba diving class, intro yoga class, non-motorized water sports, guided nature walks, and sports facilities.*

Deposit and Booking Requirements

- This quotation is subject to the availability of all services at the time of making a reservation.

- **Registration:** A 25% deposit of the total land price, per person is required. The remainder of the cost is due 60 days prior to departure date. Airline tickets must be purchased within two weeks of reservation confirmation.
- **Payment** is accepted by personal check, company check or credit card.
- **Reservation Policy:** All tariffs quoted include VAT and current grading levy. The price quoted is subject to change in the event of any unforeseen increases in fuel costs including currency fluctuations and/or Government levies/taxes, including Park Fees and Entrance fees. Safariline reserves the right to amend the quoted tariffs accordingly should the Government change the percentage level of VAT or introduce any other tax or Levy. Safariline will not cancel a tour, holiday or other travel arrangement once the client has paid in full unless it becomes necessary to do so as a result of hostilities, war or threat of war, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist unrest, active or threatened natural or nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions or if a group tour does not have a minimum required participants, or for any other adverse event beyond the control of Safariline.
