~ Itinerary Description ~

Day 1: Arrival at Mt. Meru

Meet the Asilia Specialist Guide and driver on arrival into Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer to River Trees Country Lodge where you will overnight in serene and tranquil surroundings. The Specialist Guide will host dinner and introduce you to the vibrant safari itinerary for the beginning of this walking adventure.

Day 2&3: Tarangire National Park

After breakfast at the lodge, you will depart with your Guide and a driver to transfer to Tarangire National Park. On arrival at Oliver's Camp, the group will have time to freshen up and settle in. After high tea, the group will depart on their first walk in the wilderness. Upon return from the walk and if the group wishes to extend their activity to a night safari drive, this is available at an additional cost. The next day offers morning and afternoon walks with your expert walking guide to explore the area!

Day 4 – 6: Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast, pack your bags and bid farewell to Tarangire. Depart by road transfer to Lemala Camp in the Ngorongoro Crater region, stopping along the way for a picnic lunch. After arriving in camp, the afternoon will be spent following the ancient Maasai trails to the top of the Olmoti crater. The gentle 2-3 hour ascent leads through mountain forest, grassland and rocky outcrops and is a birder & botanist's dream.

Wake up the next day with the rising sun and begin the drive from camp to the Ngorongoro Crater rim to explore the crater floor for wildlife. Lunch will be served on the crater floor, then, you may continue your exploration or venture back to camp.

After an early breakfast on the third day, leave camp for the relatively unknown Empakaai Crater. The descent is 30-45 minutes. For the more adventurous, the walk around the 6km lake takes around 4 hours; After, head back to the vehicle and stop off to visit one of the local Maasai communities.

Day 7&8: Serengeti National Park

After an early breakfast, pack your bags and depart with your Asilia Specialist Guide and driver for Serengeti National Park. Due to walking restrictions, this will be a mobile based safari with morning and afternoon game drives, which allows exploring the Serengeti to our hearts content. On arrival in camp, you will have some time to refresh and relax before heading for dinner, where you will enjoy a delicious 3 course meal and listen to the sounds of the night.

Day 9 – 11: Ruaha National Park

After breakfast, your packed bags will be collected and depart to Seronera Airstrip for your flight to Arusha Airport. From Arusha you will fly to Msembe airstrip in Ruhua where you will be met by your driver and transferred to Kwihala Camp for dinner and overnight.

Each day, the morning walk will last for around 3-4 hours. Picnic lunches will be served under the shade of the large baobabs that dot the landscape, before journeying back to camp. In the evenings, dinners will be enjoyed around the camp fire and reflections of the safari held in late night conversations.

Day 12: Departure

After breakfast, pack your bags and depart with your Asilia driver for the airstrip. Board your flight to Arusha for the trip home or Zanzibar for the optional Extension. On arrival at Zanzibar Airport you will be met by a representative, Island Express, and transferred by road to Matemwe Lodge.

Day 13 & 14: Zanzibar Extension

There are a variety of activities available either at Matemwe Lodge, or that can be arranged through reception. Activities outside of the resort can usually be booked at 24 hours' notice. On the last day, a Day Room can be booked at Matemwe for late flights out.

- Meals from Lunch on Day one to the end of the scheduled safari and a reasonable amount of drinks.
- Transportation by 4X4 specially designed safari vehicle, with qualified driver, for all journeys specified.
- English Speaking tour guide and tracker services for walking experience.

Services Not Included:

- International airfare and airport taxes quoted separately

Deposit and Booking Requirements

- This quotation is subject to the availability of all services at the time of making a reservation.
- Travel insurance coverage for injury, illness or loss of effects while on tour is NOT included, is highly recommended for travel and compulsory for many lodges and adventure safaris in Southern and Eastern Africa.
- **Registration:** A 25% deposit of the total land price, per person is required. The remainder of the cost is due 60 days prior to departure date. Airline tickets must be purchased within two weeks of reservation confirmation.
- **Payment** is accepted by personal check, company check or credit card.
- **Reservation Policy:** All tariffs quoted include VAT and current grading levy. The price quoted is subject to change in the event of any unforeseen increases in fuel costs including currency fluctuations and/or Government levies/taxes, including Park Fees and Entrance fees. Safariline reserves the right to amend the quoted tariffs accordingly should the Government change the percentage level of VAT or introduce any other tax or Levy. Safariline will not cancel a tour, holiday or other travel arrangement once the client has paid in full unless it becomes necessary to do so as a result of hostilities, war or threat of war, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist unrest, active or threatened natural or nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions or if a group tour does not have a minimum required participants, or for any other adverse event beyond the control of Safariline.
