

~ DETAILED ITINERARY ~ WINGS OVER TANZANIA & ZANZIBAR

Day 1

ARUSHA, TANZANIA

On arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport, proceed thru immigration and customs formalities, collect your bags and proceed into the arrivals hall to meet your driver/ guide for transfer to the hotel for overnight.

Arusha Coffee Lodge



Hidden amongst one of Tanzania's largest coffee plantations the Arusha Coffee Lodge is surrounded by some of Africa's most famous landscapes and national parks. Beautifully positioned below the rugged peaks of Mount Meru this

exclusive, boutique hotel lodge has been designed around the farms' original plantation homes, radiating the warmth and invitation of the old colonial plantation. It is the perfect sanctuary to immerse you in pure luxury. Walk across the manicured garden and into the coffee plantation, where paths lead through the coffee bushes to the 18 chalets, which are lovely red-brick buildings with terracotta-colored tin roofs. They are built in the style of old plantation houses and have lots of character. Once inside, these split-level rooms are spacious and very comfortable. They are furnished with a sumptuous double bed, a small lounge area and an en-suite bathroom. There is even a fire place which can be lit on cool nights.

Day 2 & 3

TARANGARIE NATIONAL PARK

Depart this morning for the airstrip and your private aircraft flight to Tarangarie National Park and two night stay.

TARANGARIE TREE TOPS



Many a childhood would have been spent playing in the world of 'make-believe'. Within this imaginary existence, many of us will have climbed and played high up in the bows and branches and, for the lucky few, built a 'palace' in the sky. It is this nostalgic sparkle that is all too visible in the eyes of the 'grown-ups' who gaze upon Tarangarie Treetops for the first time. Tarangarie Treetops sits serenely in a private game reserve bordering the Tarangarie National Park. As you arrive at the Lodge, you are immediately

greeted by a blaze of color and a host of smiles all of which belong to the local Maasai tribesmen who have become part of the enchanting story that is Tarangire Treetops.

Centered about a Main Lodge – which itself encases a thousand year-old baobab tree – Tarangire Treetops comprises 20 tree houses all of which are perched high above the ground in the broad bows of Marula and Baobab trees. Each tree house boasts one of the largest bedrooms to be found in any camp or lodge in East Africa – each with a floor space of 65 square meters – and all with an exotic double shower en suite bathroom. With furnishings that create warmth and demonstrate a commitment to local craftsmanship, the ‘up-in-the-air’ experience is completed by the open-fronted room design affording views across the Tarangire Plains from an expansive but private balcony.

Dining at Treetops sustains the momentum of undeniably memorable moments. Whether enjoying a lantern-lit dinner in a traditional Boma echoing to the sounds of Maasai chants, or eating poolside by candlelight whilst a wealth of wildlife comes to drink at the Lodge water hole, Treetops creates memories by the minute and in so many differing ways.

Tarangire is the sixth largest national park in Tanzania. The park is famous for its huge number of elephants, baobab trees and tree climbing lions. Visitors to the park can expect to see any number of resident zebra and wildebeest in addition to the less common animals. Home to more than 550 species, the park is a haven for bird enthusiasts who can expect to see dozens of species even in the dry season. The swamps are the focus of the largest selection of breeding birds anywhere in the world. Walking safaris and both day and night game drives are available. Other activities include Bush lunches and dinners, Sundowners, and tours of the local Maasai Village. The Maasai Village is about 20-30 minutes drive from Treetops and gives a perfect insight to the life of the Maasai.

Day 4 & 5

NGORONGORO HIGHLANDS

Depart this morning for the airstrip and your private aircraft flight from Tarangire to Manyara National Park. Enjoy a game driver before continuing to the Ngorongoro Highlands and your lodging for the next two nights.

The Manor



Crossing the Rift Valley and climbing the steppe onto the green and rolling hills south of the Ngorongoro Crater, there lies a truly undeniable surprise and one that will be a home-away-from-home. The Manor at Ngorongoro, with its 20 luxurious cottages and magnificent Main House, is one of the first safari lodges of its kind to blend East African hospitality with old-world Afro-European architecture and décor. Located adjacent to the famous Ngorongoro conservation area and within the 1500-acre arabica coffee estate, The Manor is reminiscent of an elegant up-country farm home in the Cape Dutch-style of architecture. The Manor at Ngorongoro provides the perfect place to relax and take in the outstanding natural beauty of its gardens and the adjacent coffee-bush laden hills. However the drama that is Africa is but a short distance away. For Ngorongoro Crater is famed as being the ‘Eighth Wonder of the World’, and is a ‘must see’ on anyone’s itinerary.

Every detail of The Manor has been crafted with its guests' comfort in mind. Each of the cottages has been carefully positioned to maximise the views of the adjacent verdant hills but, at the same time, to maintain the intimacy and privacy of this old-world manor home.

Take a tour of the Ngorongoro Crater - with its 18-kilometre wide crater floor - it is home to an abundant and unique ecosystem that encompasses all of the wildlife that you would wish to see in Africa. This spectacular setting is an 'once-in-a-lifetime' opportunity to experience the rawness and beauty of Africa's natural flora and fauna. Your full day safari experience would not be complete without enjoying a delicious campaign style luncheon, served under canopy at one of the picnic areas in the Crater. Surrounded by game and the crater rim beyond, this is the most dramatic and beautiful picnic lunch you ever likely to take. The Manor is also blessed with excellent stables and horses to match. A most enjoyable way to take in the environment of The Manor is to take to the saddle and be taken on a one hour long trek around the hills that embrace the Manor. Other activities include a tour of Lake Manyara, Bike riding, picnics, and sundowners in the garden.

Day 6 & 7

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast do a short road transfer to Manyara airstrip for your flight into the heart of the Serengeti at Lobo. Located in north west Tanzania the Serengeti is the ultimate 'wildlife show' on earth. Across the globe authors and filmmakers have come to document the Annual Migration of hundreds of thousands of animals, but there is still only one way to understand and experience the true magnificence of this natural phenomena and that is to be part of it.

SERENGETI MIGRATION CAMP (Optional - Pioneer Camp available)



Serengeti Migration Camp is the embodiment of the 'camp' experience. Located next to the famous Grumeti River which is home to resident hippos that bark and wallow their days away, Serengeti Migration Camp has become synonymous with low-impact high-action game viewing in a landscape that is untouched since the dawn of time. Hidden among the rocky outcrops Serengeti Migration Camp is located at the starting point of the Migration. Comprising of 20 luxurious elevated tents, each with spacious and richly furnished bedrooms, it blends seamlessly into the environment.

Each of the tents is surrounded by its own 360-degree verandah deck, which in turn creates your very own private sanctuary to enjoy the constant game sightings and the ever-present sounds of the bush. The main 'tent' has a split-level lounge, a swimming pool, restaurant and viewing platforms that offer views across the river and the rugged landscape beyond.

It is the drama and proximity of the wild, which takes the experience of this camp to an altogether higher level. Whether it is walking safaris with experienced and highly knowledgeable guides or the sensation of being as close to nature's daily fight for survival, the sensory feast that accompanies any a visit Serengeti Migration Camp will no doubt rival anything experienced before.

Day 8 / Extension Day 8 -11 DEPARTURE OR ZANZIBAR EXTENSION

After a morning activity and breakfast depart for the airstrip for your flight to Zanzibar and Pemba (if at Fundu Lagoon) or depart from Arusha Airport.

On arrival transfer to the lodge for the next four nights.

FUNDU LAGOON, PEMBA – OPTIONAL EXTENSION



This remote and peaceful resort, set on a beautiful beach on the south west of Pemba Island, is only accessible by boat. The hotel is privately owned and run with a love for the natural environment that surrounds it. Wood walkways and sandy paths lead to eighteen Makuti thatched tented rooms and suites. Comfortable soothing sea breezes and the multitude of ceiling fans in the rooms all with breathtaking views of the Indian Ocean, romantic thatched room, discrete privacy and are furnished with double or twin beds. Hill side Standard rooms (1 – 8) enjoy fantastic views of the Indian Ocean. Beachfront Standard Rooms (9,10,13,14) are shaded by tropical trees and shrubs with the sandy beach on your doorstep and ocean to lull you to sleep. Three styles of suites are available; beach, jungle and superior suites offering stylish bedrooms with open plan lounge and spacious deck and private plunge pool.

Fundu is an idyllic place to unwind whether lingering poolside or enjoying the spectacular Indian ocean on a beautiful beach fringed by natural forest. The hotel offers complete privacy with three bars, an excellent restaurant and a beautiful infinity pool designed to blend naturally with a unique East African setting. The Indian Ocean surrounds Pemba and for the more active the resorts fully equipped dive centre is ready to take you to explore the marine life on surrounding coral reefs and deep drops offs. Pemba is also known for rewarding deep sea fishing and the resorts fully equipped Cobra Cat operates under IGFA guidelines. With the small barrier islands, deep drop-offs, good fishing prevails for the first time angler or most experience
